

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Preparations are in the works and we're happy to announce that classes will return to Sundays, beginning on September 15th! We will continue to offer the Family Faith Formation program for Grades K-6. Parent meetings will be held in the Parish Center hall on Sunday mornings after the 9:30 AM Mass. Two classes a month will be offered, on the 1st and 3rd Sundays, from 10:30 AM to 11:30 AM. Some adjustments to the schedule are planned to coincide with the S. Burlington school calendar.

The same Sundays have been selected for our programs for Middle School students (7th-8th) and High School Confirmation class (9th grade). They'll meet on the 1st and 3rd Sundays from 6:30 PM to 7:45 PM. This is a change in time from previous years.

The Diocese of Burlington is changing the age of youth Confirmation to that of the 6th grade by the year 2022. This coming year there will be additional formation opportunities for 8th grade students to prepare for Confirmation in the spring of 2020. We will have some Confirmation sessions for parents and students of 8th and 9th grades throughout the year.

In February and March all parishioners were asked to take a survey from the Catholic Leadership Institute, by an initiative of the Diocesan Synod. A planning team has been formed to help lead our parish by growing more vibrant. Over 200 parishioners participated in the survey, and this participation is a great sign of vibrancy in itself. Our parish has strengths to build on. For example, according to the survey results, the vast majority of our Mass attendees also make it a priority to pray in their day to day life. The survey also indicates opportunities. For example, we have the opportunity to engage more parishioners in Catholic devotions, or in small groups like Bible studies.
